

6th Grade Supply List

1. One 2" 3-ring zipper binder with computer disc storage and pencil pockets (ex: Mead Five-Star First Gear Zipper Binder)
2. 1 college-rule notebook with perforated sheets, 100 sheets
3. 1 college-rule small spiral notebook (approx. 7 x 5)
4. 1 graph paper 4/5 inch quadrille, wireless, Neatbook notebook with perforated sheets
5. 2 graph paper (quad-rule) composition books, (quadrille 4 squares per inch), 80 - 100 sheets, preferably marble, non-spiral, 9 ¾ x 7 ½"
6. 3 Marble, non-spiral composition notebooks, 100 sheets - 200 pages, (9 ¾ x 7 ½" / 24.7cm x 19cm)
7. 1 package loose-leaf filler paper, 100 sheets
8. 1 package 3" x 5" note cards
9. 1 package 4" x 6" note cards
10. Pocket folders with 3 prongs
11. Pencils (non-mechanical)
12. 1 box 12 colored pencils
13. 1 hand held pencil sharpener
14. 1 pencil pouch
15. 1 compass
16. 1 protractor
17. 1 hard ruler with centimeters and inches
18. 1 large (7" +) pair scissors
19. 1 glue stick
20. Erasers
