

Lower Elementary Supply List

The following supplies become community property for Lower Elementary and are used by all students throughout the year.

All students must have:

1. 12 Ticonderoga brand pencils
2. 3 large glue sticks
3. 2 boxes washable markers
4. 1 watercolor set
5. 10 heavy duty plastic 3-prong/2 pocket folders
6. 1 pair of large scissors (1st year only)
7. 2 rolls of 2" blue painter's tape
8. Elementary level reference book on animals, nature, science, geography, history, or flags
9. Reading books (non-violent fiction/non-fiction; no comic books)
 - 1st: Easy read or beginning chapter book
 - 2nd: Beginning chapter book
 - 3rd: Chapter book
10. Many boxes of Kleenex

Amy's students must also bring:

11. 12 additional Ticonderoga pencils (total of 24)
12. 2 additional heavy duty plastic 3-prong/2 pocket folders (total of 12)
13. 1 package wide-ruled lined paper, 100 sheets
14. 1 sturdy clipboard with child's name on it (1st and new students only)
15. 3 boxes of 12 colored pencils "Crayola" or "Prisma" brand, non-erasable
16. 1 hand held pencil sharpener with child's name on it
17. 2 marble composition books, wide-rule, non-spiral, 100 sheets, 9 ¾ x 7 ½"
18. 2nd year students only: Children's Thesaurus
19. 3rd year students only: Webster Handy College or Merriam-Webster Dictionary
20. 1 washable dust cloth

Michael's students must also bring:

11. 6 marble composition books, wide-rule, non-spiral, 100 sheets, 9 ¾ x 7 ½"
12. 2 graph paper (quad-rule) composition books, (quadrille 4 squares per inch), 80 - 100 sheets, preferably marble, non-spiral, 9 ¾ x 7 ½"
13. 2 boxes Crayola *non-erasable* colored pencils

Don's students must also bring:

11. 6 marble composition books, wide-rule, non-spiral, 100 sheets, 9 ¾ x 7 ½"
12. 2 graph paper (quad-rule) composition books, (quadrille 4 squares per inch), 80 - 100 sheets, preferably marble, non-spiral, 9 ¾ x 7 ½"
13. 2 boxes Crayola *erasable* colored pencils

Optional: Small craft supplies for Art (jewels, woodsiest, foam shapes, buttons, etc.)
